1. Fees for GDTD:

	For Participants from Developed Countries / Trust-funded (SGD)	For Participants from Developing Countries (MYR)
Application Fee (non-refundable)	\$50	RM100

Fees Notes:

- Students from developed countries pay fees at the SGD rate. Students from developing (or least developed) countries pay fees at the MYR rate. Please check with the GDTD registrar (<u>gdtdregistrar@agstalliance.org</u>) if you are unsure which category you fall under.
- Students from developed countries, working in developing countries but supported financially from developed countries, and those who receive scholarship funding from trusts/foundations pay the SGD rate.
- Organization sign-ups with more than 5 students receive 10% discount on Module Fees (for Coursework and Pre-Program Module).*
- Students auditing modules will be charged 50% of the Module Fee.
- Fees are paid in advance of the component of the program they are for.

2. Refund policy

- If a student withdraws from a program, a request for fees refund may be considered; but the student should initiate the request within three months of withdrawing.
- If a student withdraws from the program for other than significant compassionate reasons, no refund of fees will be made.
- If a student has paid fees in advance, a refund equivalent to complete components of the program (e.g. MTh/EdD modules) not attended will be refundable.
- An administration fee of 10% of the amount to be refunded will be charged for fees refunds.
